Of Democracy Reporting International-Pakistan Office

We have audited the accompanying balance sheet and statement of receipt and payment of the Democracy Reporting International-Pakistan Office for the year ended December 31, 2016 and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (here-in-after referred to as the 'financial statements').

Basis of Preparation

These financial statements have been prepared by the management in accordance with the receipt and payment basis of accounting as described in note 2 thereto.

Management Responsibility for the Financial Statements

1 LEGAL STATUS AND OPERATIONS

Democracy Reporting International is a non-partisan, independent, not-for-profit organisation registered in Berlin. Democracy Reporting International promotes political participation of citizens, accountability of state bodies and development of democratic institutions world-wide. Democracy Reporting International helps support local ways of promoting the universal right of citizens to participate in political life of their country, enshrined in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR). Democracy Reporting International's work is carried out by an international network of experienced associates, each of whom have worked in democratic governance and human rights for 10 to 20 years, often in senior positions. DRI's signing an agreement (MOU) with government of Pakistan (in process with Ministry of Interior, Government of Pakistan) mainly to perform: Supporting Democratic Reforms: Elections, Constitution and Political Rights. The registered office DRI-Pakistan office is situated at 1st floor, Ufone Tower, Islamabad.

2 BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

These financial statements have been prepared on cash receipt and payment basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting, under which income is recognized when received and expenditure is recognized when paid.

2.1 FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSLATION

Receipts and expenses in foreign currency from cash and bank are recorded in Pakistan Rupee using average rate of exchange. The cash and bank balances held in foreign currencies are translated at the rates of exchange which approximates those prevailing at the reporting date. The resulting exchange gain or loss is taken to the fund balance.
