
Ukraine's Constitutional Process

3 March 2015 - 2 February 2016



President signs the Law nr. 3812 allowing the second voting on constitutional amendments in the course of any regular session of the Parliament after the session with the first voting

session")

2 February 2016

Parliament closes its third session. No second voting on the draft takes place



Possible steps for the reforms to happen

Provided the second voting on the constitutional amendments is ALLOWED at any regular session after the session with the first voting



Parliamentary Session: 2 February - July 2017

Parliament passes the bill in the second voting with at least 300 votes

Provided the second voting on the constitutional amendments is NOT allowed at any regular session after the session with the first voting

Parliament is not allowed to debate on the same provisions one year since the last consideration

Drafting and approval procedure re-starts





A new draft would require:

- declaration of constitutionality by the Constitutional Court. Any amendment made after the Court's decision would have to be reviewed by the Court;
- preliminary approval by at least 226 MPs;
- final approval by at least 300 MPs at the session following the session with the first approval.
